



### RHS Ongoing COVID Response

1. The Ministry of Health is the lead organisation. Rototuna High Schools (Senior and Junior) will follow **all** Health advice and directives. (Ongoing)
2. The Ministry of Education is the second lead agency. Rototuna High Schools (Senior and Junior) will follow **all** MoE advice and directives. (Ongoing)
3. Both schools will continue to communicate regularly with our parent and whānau community
  - a. Fortnightly newsletters from both schools
  - b. Personal emails (as required)
  - c. Facebook updates (as required)
  - d. Website updates and other platforms (Schoology for student notices)
4. Provide high-quality accurate information for staff/parents whanau via communications links (Ongoing)

We will continue to:

- Regularly clean all school facilities (Ongoing)
- Promote healthy hygiene habits for staff and students. (Ongoing)
- Require all sick/ill students and staff stay at home as per MoH/MoE requirements/advice. (Ongoing)
- Continue a hybrid learning model for students to access learning if they need to stay at home.

In the event that the school system is severely disrupted by COVID (high numbers of staff absences):

- **Rototuna SENIOR High** School will implement a **remote learning schedule for all students off-site at home**. A **reduced onsite** curriculum will be **scheduled (workshops)** and students individually contacted to attend.
- **Rototuna JUNIOR High** School will implement a hybrid learning model that requires all students who are not isolating or unwell to attend school and be supported with the modules online in their Hapū. Any students isolating, that are healthy, should be completing online learning tasks at home.
